



## **Jeffersontown/Chenoweth Run – XL Pilot Project Stakeholder Meeting Summary**

The following is a general summary of key discussion topics. It is not intended that every comment or suggestion is necessarily captured herein.

**PROJECT UPDATE** – Sharon Worley gave a brief update on the project status. She noted that the Final Project Agreement had been signed by EPA, KY Division of Water and MSD in September 2000. Since that time, work has been done to compile and summarize the data from the first two years of sampling. That data will be discussed tonight. The project will not officially begin (according to the federal regulations) until EPA grants authority in the Federal Register. Publication of the Federal Register notice is expected soon.

**OVERVIEW OF PERFORMANCE MEASURES** – Mark Sneve, Strand Associates, presented the findings from the first two years of sampling. The presentation slides are attached (with some minor corrections noted).

**OVERVIEW OF WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (WTP) INFORMATION** – Debbie Newton, MSD Regional Manager, noted that the WTP has been operating well. Several upgrades/improvements have been made over the last couple of years, including addition of Phosphorus removal equipment, addition of Ultraviolet Light Disinfection (and the subsequent elimination of Chlorine), addition of Primary Clarifiers which allow for the treatment of wet weather flow, and addition of odor control. Additional odor control improvements will be installed over the next year.

**WATERSHED PLANNING** – David Hoeh, private consultant, gave a brief introduction to the work that he has begun for the development of a focused watershed planning effort for the Chenoweth Run area. The purpose of the watershed planning effort is to provide a comprehensive view of influences in the watershed, and then to identify where actions might be taken that would help maintain the function and character of the watershed. A meeting on this subject will be held on May 29 at 7pm in the Jeffersontown Public Library. **SALT RIVER WATERSHED WATCH** – Bruce Scott, Salt River Watershed Watch, spoke about the need for volunteers for the Salt River Watershed Watch stream monitoring efforts. If interested, volunteers were encouraged to attend a training session on April 28.
